Compliance with HB 3693

All cities will comply with the requirements of House Bill 3693 (Government Code § 2265.001(b)) by compiling and posting the following information as soon as practicable after January 1, 2019:

- 1) The total metered amount of electricity, water and natural gas used by the city or governmental entity for its services in 2018.
- 2) The total amount paid for electricity, water and natural gas in 2018.

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2018

The City of Port Lavaca purchases natural gas from CenterPoint Energy. In Calendar Year 2018, the City purchased a total of 143.4 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City of Port Lavaca purchases electricity from GEXA Energy¹ and Victoria Electric Co-op. In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 3,800,303 kilowatt hours.

The City of Port Lavaca purchases water from the Guadalupe Blanco River Authority (GBRA). In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 459,537,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2018 is \$1,520,649.78
