

**CITY OF PORT LAVACA, TEXAS
MAYORAL AMENDED ORDER
RELATING TO COVID-19
SOCIAL DISTANCING FOR CITY-OWNED PROPERTIES**

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus; and

WHEREAS, Greg Abbott, Governor of Texas, issued Executive Order GA-28 on June 3, 2020 and amended that Order on June 23, 2020 authorizing Judges and Mayors to impose additional restrictions on gatherings in excess of one hundred (100) people; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to spread and to pose an increasing imminent threat of disaster as indicated by the Victoria County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port Lavaca, Texas, is taking extraordinary measures to prevent the spread of this potentially devastating disease in our community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PORT LAVACA, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. In accordance with the Guidelines from the Governor, every person in the City of Port Lavaca, Texas, shall avoid outdoor social gatherings in groups of more than one hundred (100) people on any property owned by the City of Port Lavaca, Texas.

SECTION 2. That the Bauer Community Center is limited to 250 people in attendance of any event.

SECTION 3. That this order hereby authorizes the use of all lawfully available enforcement tools.

SECTION 4. That this order shall take effect on Monday, June 29, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. from and after its issuance unless lifted or further extended by separate order.
